A trend in the stamp production is the flash technology. Heri now offers the “Mini Flash Machine”, which is an easy and low cost alter-

Beside the Machine and the technique service, Heri offers all necessary materials such as film, protection foil, special adhesive tape, Inking trays, black stamping ink. The Mini Flash Machine offers a lot of different distribution chances and marketing strategies for the StampPens.
